# Timeline for NJ 2025 SHSP

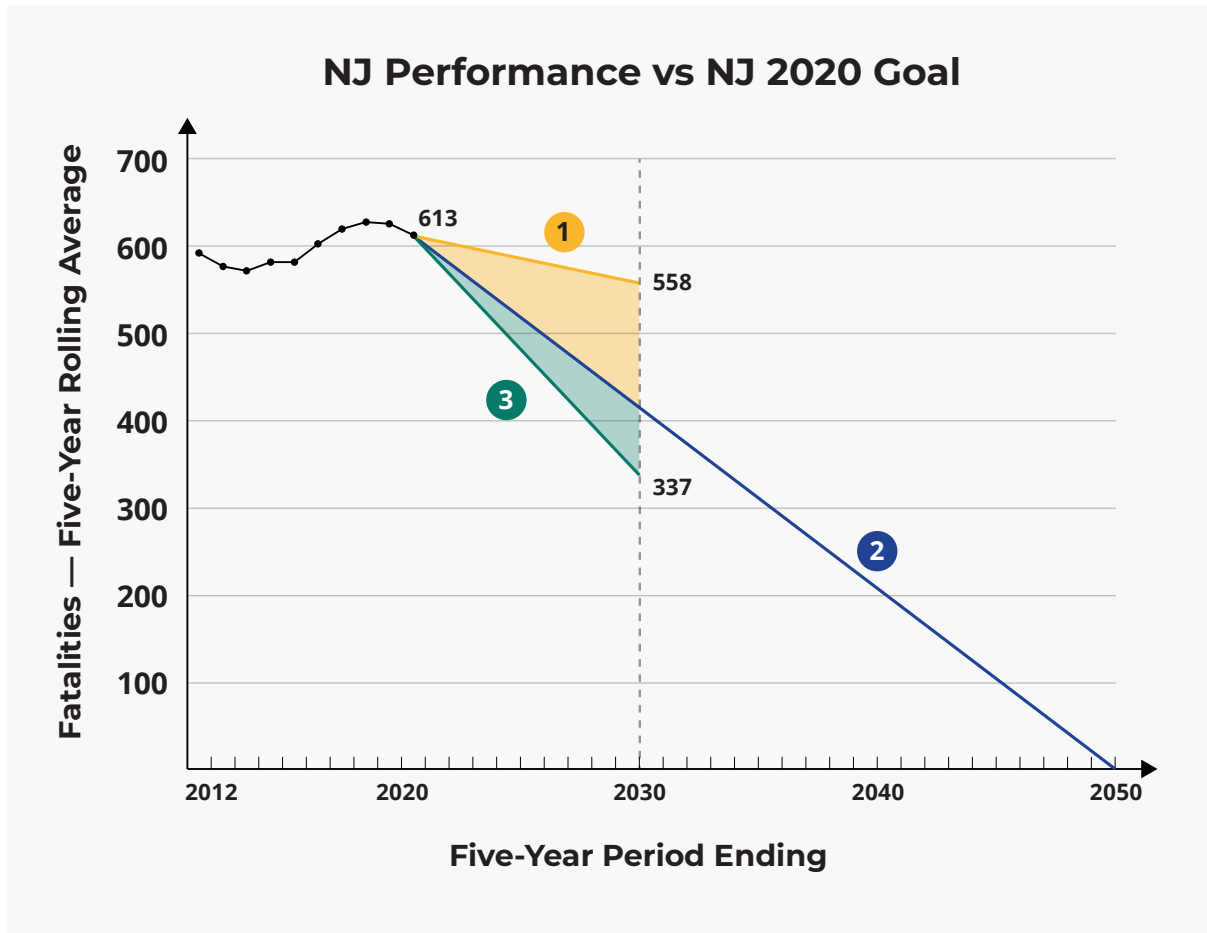
- Planning for NJ 2025 SHSP will begin by first quarter of 2024

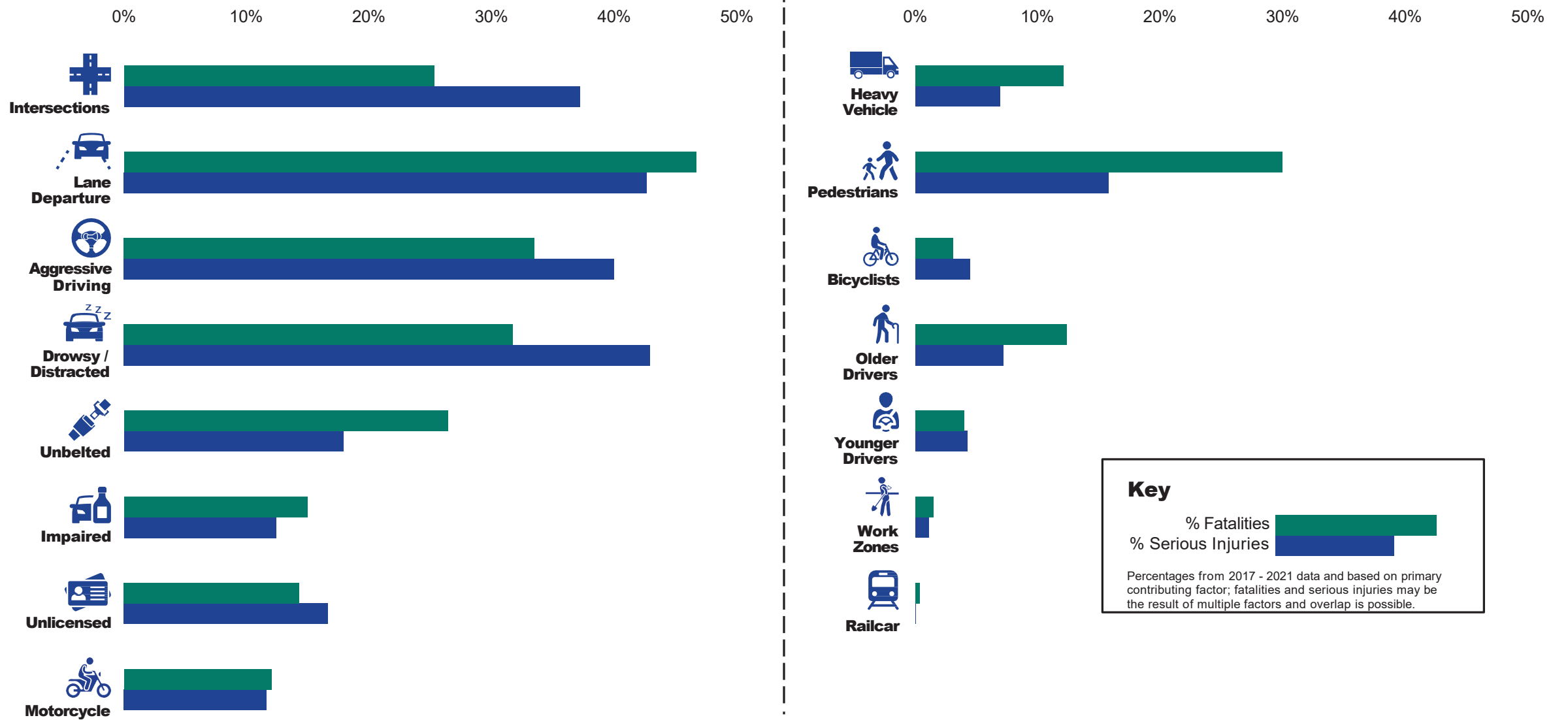
