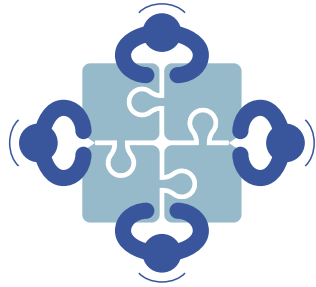


	2022 Compared to 2021

 Bicyclists	▼38%

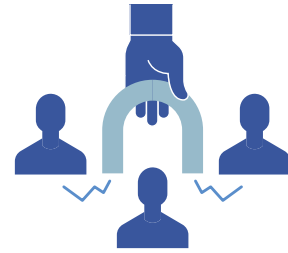


	2023 Compared to 2022, Year-to-Date

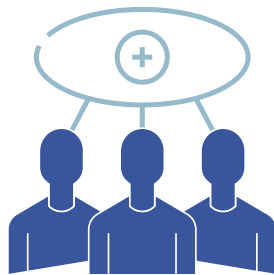
